

Pinellas Schools Referendum Renewal in November

Since 2004, voters have regularly approved a ½ mill property tax to enhance Pinellas school funding. The next renewal is on this November's ballot.

The ballot language REQUIRES this money be spent to recruit and retain quality teachers, preserve reading programs and music and art classes, and provide current textbooks and technology.

In 2019, the average single-family homeowner paid less than \$86, producing \$44.5 million for our schools.

The Referendum provides a dedicated local source of funding over and above State monies. Every penny benefits Pinellas students and spending is monitored by an independent citizen oversight committee.
